Taking Ideas Further (Stage 1)

This involves expanding upon some of the art activities developed in Stage 1 creating a variety of different outcomes. These tasks can be carried out as individual sessions or split throughout a class with different groups completing different tasks.

Colour/Patterns Emotions Masks

Pupils choose one of their speed emotion drawings to develop. Re drawing them A4 Portrait size they then draw shapes that describe the emotions of the face and select colours that best express them



E.g. Angry, Puzzled, Happy, Angry.

Angry relates to reds, blacks and greys and is shown in strong angular shapes and mark making. Shyness could relate to pale colours and pinks and be shown as very swirling patterns

They can also collage these faces and develop them into masks use different types of paper, fabric and colouring equipment.

When all masks are completed they can be arranged and fastened together to create a large two dimensional work, creating a blanket effect or banner type display.
